Activities will be cancelled at the discretion of the Headteacher and/or Governing Body.

Please login to Schoolmoney to make payment and consent to this trip. Your response is required by Friday, 18th May. **If your reply is not received by this date, your child will have to remain in school on the day of the trip.**

If your child is unwell or unable to attend on the day of the trip, a refund may be considered but will be dependent on the terms of payment agreed with the venue.

Participation in school trips is dependent on your child displaying appropriate behaviour and discipline in school prior to the trip. Staff reserve the right to assess the suitability of pupils and if necessary withdraw them from the trip at any stage prior to the event.



If your child is asthmatic or diabetic, you must ensure that any appropriate medication is given to the class teacher first thing in the morning.

Children will not be taken if their medication is not provided.
