## School Trip

<b>Year Group involved</b>	Year 1
<b>Date of visit</b>	26 <sup>th</sup> November
<b>Venue</b>	Food Museum, Stowmarket

### Actions required:

<b>1.</b>	Payment and consent via SchoolMoney by <b>Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November</b>
<b>2.</b>	If a UIFSM school packed lunch is required - Notify school office on Form by <b>Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November</b>

As part of our remembering the past unit in history, children will be studying how food, clothing, cars and shops have changed within living memory. At the food museum, children will take part in a history of food workshop where they will have the opportunity to visit Dairy cottages to look at the kitchen and old dairy. They will also explore the similarities and difference between tea time today and in the past. This experience should bring the history to life for the children and make learning about the past more meaningful.

Children will need to wear school uniform and comfortable footwear, as there will be quite a bit of walking. They will also need to bring something warm and rainproof as part of the day will be outside.

A packed lunch is required for the day. Your child is entitled to Universal Infant Free School Meals. Please inform the school office by completing the Form by **8<sup>th</sup> November** if you would like the school to provide the packed lunch. In any case, you will need to provide sufficient drinks for the day – no fizzy drinks or glass bottles please.

As the children may have to carry their lunches around with them, we suggest they are in a small rucksack or other suitable carrier.

The coach will leave school at the beginning of the school day, and will return in time for the usual end of day collection arrangements. The cost of the trip will be £10.50.

Please indicate whether you would like your child to participate in this activity by logging in to SchoolMoney to make payment and consent by Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November. We are unable to take children if we have not received consent.

If your child is unwell or unable to attend on the day of the trip, a refund may be considered but will be dependent on the terms of payment agreed with the venue and coach company.

If your child suffers from travel sickness please administer medication before arrival at school on the day. If your child is asthmatic or diabetic, you must ensure that any appropriate medication is given to the class teacher first thing in the morning, as we are unable to take children if this is not provided.

We really hope that the children have a very positive experience and that they look forward to enriching their knowledge in this way.
